

CERTification Program Testing Policy Effective January 27, 2020

To be eligible for admission, an applicant:

- 1. shall have a grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5 before admission or a 2.5 GPA in the last 60 semester credit hours on all coursework, including content specific, previously attempted at an accredited Institute of Higher Education (IHE).
- 2. seeking a career and technical education (CTE) certificate that does not require a degree from an accredited IHE is exempt from the minimum GPA requirement.
- 3. shall have 12 semester credit hours in the subject-specific content area for the certification sought, unless certification sought is for mathematics or science at or above Grade 7;

shall have 15 semester credit hours in the subject-specific content area for the certification sought if the certification sought is mathematics or science at or above Grade 7;

or

shall have a passing score on the appropriate **TX PACT** examination as specified in the figure provided in this subparagraph for the **calendar year** during which the applicant seeks admission.
